**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 23**

**PROPOSED TOUCAN CROSSING – GREAT NORTH ROAD (THREE MILE BRIDGE)**

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police gives notice of its intention to establish (install) a toucan crossing at the following location:-
  - (i) **Great North Road** – 69.4 metres south of its junction with Bridge Park (the controlled area will be 34 metres).
2. The proposed toucan crossing is necessary to facilitate pedestrians and cyclists crossing the above road.
3. A copy of this Notice and a plan showing the location of the proposed crossing may be viewed free of charge for 21 days after publication of this Notice at the Customer Service Centre, Civic Centre (Ground Floor), Sandyford Road, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE1 8QH between 9.00 am to 4.30 pm Monday to Friday.
