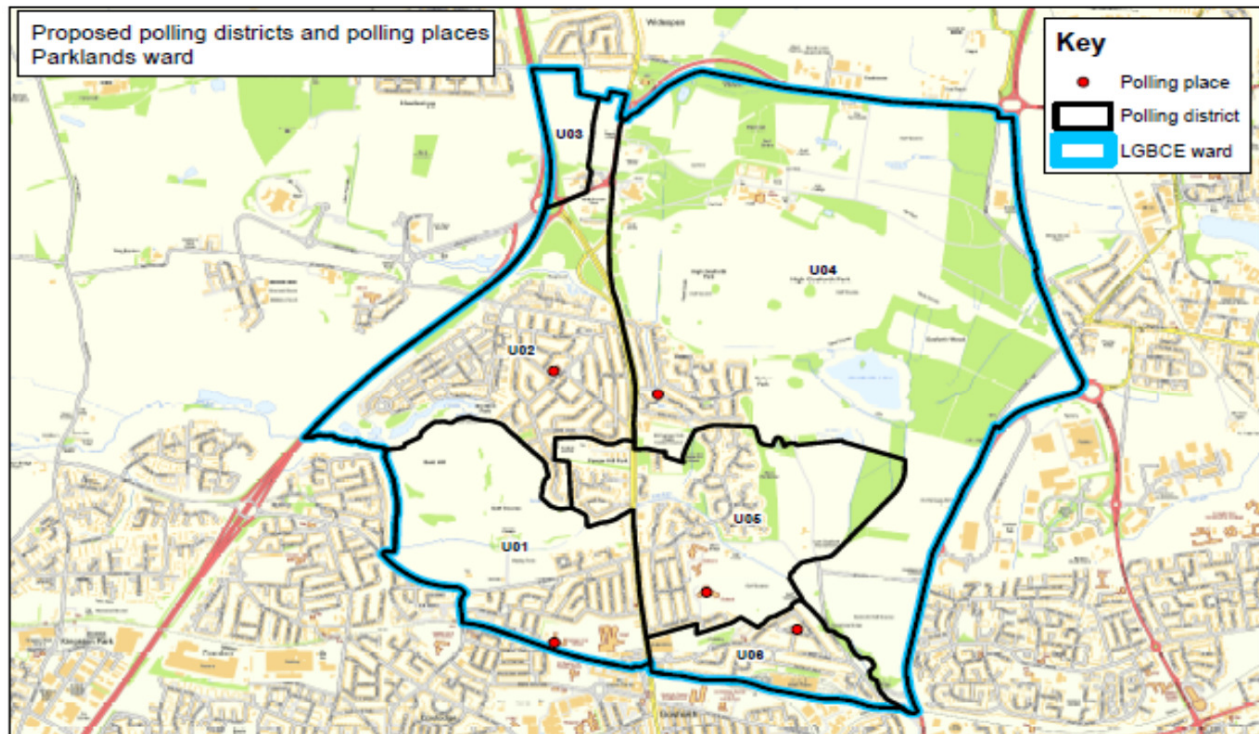


Ward: Parklands (U)

Parklands ward gains the the Gosforth Garden Village area from former East Gosforth ward, creating U06. Electors in that area will see no change to district boundaries or polling place. The remainder of the ward sees no change to district boundaries or polling places. However a replacement for the temporary cabin in Melton Park (U04) is being sought. New polling district U03 is created to protect the North Gosforth Parish Council boundaries. The ward is wholly within North Parliamentary Constituency.
