

West Fenham Annual Ward Priorities 2019-2020

Feedback from public consultation carried out between 2 September 2019 – 4 October 2019.

Residents were consulted in a variety of ways:

- Online (via Let's Talk Newcastle) – 11 responses
- By post (through flyer distributed to every household in the ward) – 5 responses
- Pop up face to face events at English Martyrs' School, King George Fields, Denton Dene North, Stocksfield Avenue Primary School and Waterbeach Place – 22 people

Number of people who agreed with current ward priorities: 35 out of 38
